

WMS/WHS Winter Sports Spectator Policy

The WMS/WHS Athletic Department is excited to welcome back limited spectators for our winter sports! Per Governor Murphy's executive order issued on Friday, February 12, 2021, school districts may choose to allow up to two parents/guardians per participating athlete under the age of 21 to attend competitions, as long as attendance does not cause indoor events to exceed 35% of the room's capacity or 150 people total.

Tickets:

- Each WMS/WHS student-athlete will receive two "season passes".
 - Passes will be used by parents/guardians (adults only) to gain entry into WMS/WHS **HOME** events only.
 - Passes are non-transferrable and are only to be used by the parents/guardians of the student-athlete they were issued to.
 - No new passes will be issued for originals that were lost or misplaced.
 - Siblings with the same parents/caregivers will only be issued passes for those parents/caregivers.

*Due to social distancing mandates, only WMS/WHS parents/guardians are allowed to attend WMS/WHS **HOME** games. Parents/guardians from the opposing team will not be allowed to attend.

Masks/Face Coverings:

- Upon arrival, all spectators must be wearing a mask or face covering that completely covers their mouth and nose.
- Masks/face coverings must be worn at all times inside the building.
 - WMS/WHS has always prohibited food and drink from being brought into the gymnasium and will continue to do so.
 - No concessions will be sold during this season.

*Individuals not abiding by the mask/face covering policy will be denied entry or, if already in the building, will be asked to leave.

Screening Procedure:

- Prior to entering the gymnasium, parents/guardians will be required to complete the following screening procedure:
 - Visual check that mask/face covering is being worn properly.
 - Temperature check
 - Anyone with a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees will not be allowed to enter.

- COVID-19 symptom questionnaire (verbal confirmation)

*We kindly ask that if you are not feeling well, then please stay home. Our live stream production will continue to operate as it has all season.

Seating/Social Distancing

- Seating in the bleachers will be marked to ensure social distancing.
- Location of seats will be randomly selected prior to the game and assignments given to parties upon arrival.
 - Parties must sit in their designated location to help with contact tracing purposes if needed.
- Seats will be grouped in pairs per student-athlete.
 - If the parents/guardians of a student-athlete do not wish to sit in pairs and would like to be socially distanced from each other, then this request must be made in advance.

As stated before, we are excited to welcome Warrior Nation back in the building for our basketball games, even if it is in a limited capacity! We hope that the numbers continue to trend in the right direction and that this phase of reopening goes well. We are all tasked with doing our part in remaining socially distanced, properly wearing masks/face coverings, washing our hands often, and staying home when ill. Thank you in advance for your adherence to these policies/procedures and keeping our student-athletes, staff, and other spectators safe.
